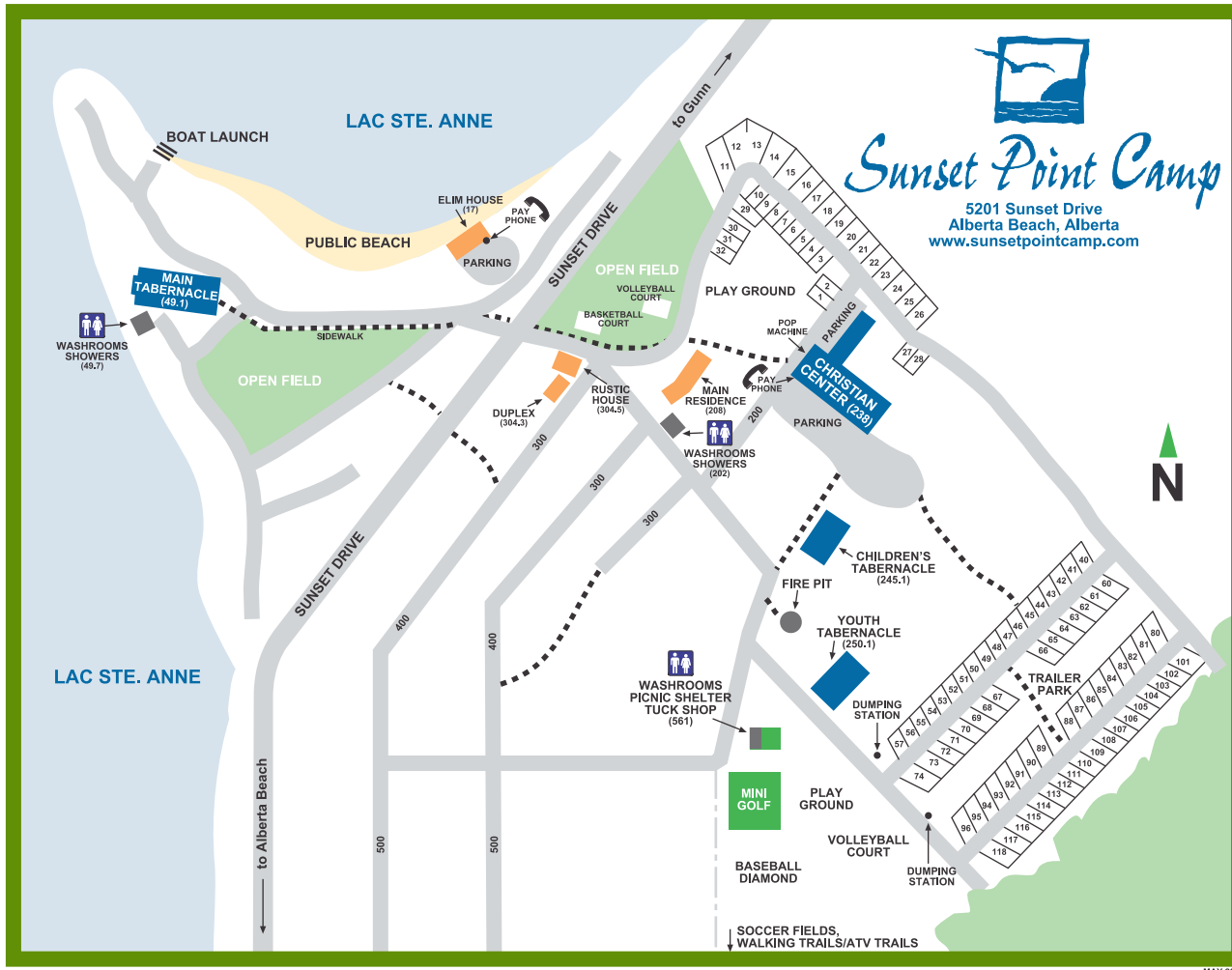

## Rates & Costs

### New This Year! Tuck Shop

There will be a variety of sugary goodies available for purchase at certain times during the day!

#### Individual Costs

Cabin with WC \$105.00 per night  
(may include up to 6 people)

Cabin \$55.00 per night  
(may include up to 4 people)

Tenting \$23.00 (\$24 with power) per night  
(large families flat rate \$25 per night)

Trailer/RV \$42.00 per night  
(sewer, power & water)

Tent Trailer \$31.00 per night  
(power & water)

Hotel Room \$55.00 per night  
(1 queen)

Hotel Room \$65.00 per night  
(1 queen & 1 double)

Hotel Room \$75.00 per night  
(2 queens)

For those staying in the Hotel (Elim Lodge) if there are more than 5 families staying there is a small kitchen and the Beach meeting room for \$200 a day. Depending on the numbers of rooms this may drop to \$150 a day.

## What to Expect

This camp is about friendships, relaxation and praise. Everyone who was able to come out had a great time of fellowship.

What we do is have a chapel time twice a day. This is at 10:00 am and at 7:00 pm. The short services includes a hymn sing and a sermon.

These are the only scheduled times during the camp. There will be one exception this year; a talent night will take place after the evening chapel time on the Wednesday night

In the evenings we gather round the camp fire to make s'mores, swap stories, discuss theology share, pray, sing, etc.

During the day there is fishing, walking, sports, playgrounds, eating, board games, discussions, prayer, etc.

There are Cabins, Full Service RV Sites, Tent Sites, and Dorm Rental Units. A brand new hotel has also been opened which now has rooms available.

There is also a Picnic Shelter, Washrooms with Hot Showers, Laundry Machines, and Playgrounds.

Activities include Lake Front Beach/Swimming, Campfires, Nature Trails, Sport Fields, Mini Golf and Sand Volleyball.
