Lesson 17 | Diligence and Laziness

Laziness in Proverbs is more than a character flaw; it is a significant moral issue. In Proverbs, the sluggard is contrasted with the righteous, highlighting the connection between laziness and vice. He is never equated with the "poor" because they are such by virtue of circumstances beyond their control, whereas he is poor by virtue of his moral degeneracy.
