ABIDING

PRAYER GUIDE



hile interacting with His disciples, Jesus implored them to abide in Him (John 15:4). To abide can also mean to 'remain in' or to 'continue in'. Disciples who abide in Christ will bear fruit, they will pray and they will keep His commandments. Jesus specifically stated, "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and *so* prove to be My disciples" (John 15:7-8). Those who abide in Christ have gloriously free and open access to ask God whatever they wish that is consistent with His Word and will. And so, as we abide in Christ we *must* pray!

Scripture calls us to pray: "With all prayer," "pray at all times," "petition for all the saints," "devote yourselves to prayer" (see Ephesians 6:18, Colossians 4:2-3 to cite a few examples). This guide aims to provide you with a plan and encouragement for you to pray.

Note that each month is divided into four weeks rather than specific dates. Each week of the month focuses on a different ministry area to pray for: evangelism, missions, and the local church. For missions, we would have liked to include specific requests from our missionaries. Since these requests frequently change, we encourage you to sign up for their monthly newsletters and add their prayer requests to your list.

We hope this prayer guide encourages you this year and challenges you to greater and more fervent prayer. Please join with us as we abide in the Lord through prayer and keep on the alert as to how He will answer these prayers!

God

Created and owns everything

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth (Gen 1:1).

The earth is the LORD's, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it (Ps 24:1).

Is perfectly holy

... that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all (1 John 1:5).

Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect (Matt 5:48; cf. Lev 11:44–45, 19:2).

Requires perfect obedience to His law

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one *point*, he has become guilty of all (Jas 2:10).

Man

Has broken God's law

... There is none righteous, not even one ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Rom 3:10, 23).

Will pay the eternal penalty for sin

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord (Rom 6:23).

Cannot save himself by his good works

He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but

according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the

Christ

Came to earth as both God and sinless man

For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form (Col 2:9).

Demonstrated God's love by dying on the cross to pay sin's penalty

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us (Rom 5:8).

He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor 5:21; cf. John 3:16; 1 Pet 2:24).

Rose from the grave and is alive today

And that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the

Scriptures (1 Cor 15:4).

Sinners

Must repent of all that dishonors God

Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him

return to the LORD, and He will have compassion on him, and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon (Isa 55:7).

 \ldots If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross

daily and follow Me (Luke 9:23).

Must believe in Christ as Lord and Savior

That if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved (Rom 10:9).

Will you repent and believe in Christ?
