

## Week 1: June 1-7

Colossians 1:1-2

1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and

Timothy our brother,

2 To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ in Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father.

## Week 3: June 15-21

Colossians 1:5-6

5 because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the gospel

6 which has come to you, just as in all the world also it is constantly bearing fruit and multiplying, just as it has been doing in you also since the day you heard and understood the grace of God in truth;

## Week 2: June 8-14

Colossians 1:3-4

3 We give thanks to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, 4 since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and the love which you have for all the saints,

## Week 4: June 22-28

Colossians 1:8-7

7 just as you learned it from Epaphras, our beloved fellow slave, who is a faithful servant of Christ on our behalf, 8 who also informed us of your love in the Spirit.

## Week 5: June 29- July 5

Colossians 1:9-10

9 For this reason also, since the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the full knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,

10 so that you may walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and multiplying in the full knowledge of God;

## Week 6: July 6-12

Colossians 1: 11-12

11 being strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously

12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

## Week 7: July 13-19

Colossians 1:13-14

13 Who rescued us from the authority of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of the Son of His love, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

## Week 8: July 20-26

Colossians 1:15-16

15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

16 For in Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

## Week 9: July 27- Aug 2

Colossians 1: 17-18

17 And He is before all things,

And in Him all things hold together.

18 And He is the head of the body, the church;  
Who is the beginning, the firstborn from the  
dead, so that He Himself will come to have  
first place in everything.

## Week 11: August 10-16

Colossians 1: 21-22

21 And although you were formerly alienated  
and enemies in mind and in evil deeds,

22 but now He reconciled you in the body of  
His flesh through death, in order to present  
you before Him holy and blameless and  
beyond reproach—

## Week 13: August 24-30

Colossians 1:25-26

25 of which I was made a minister according to the  
stewardship from God given to me for you, so that I  
might fully carry out the preaching of the word of God,  
26 that is, the mystery which has been hidden from the  
past ages and generations, but has now been manifested  
to His saints,

## Week 15: Sept 7-13

Colossians 1:29- 2:1

29 For this purpose I also labor, striving  
according to His working, which He works in  
me in power

1 For I want you to understand how great a  
struggle I have on your behalf and for those who  
are at Laodicea, and for all those who have not  
seen my face in the flesh,

## Week 10: August 3-9

Colossians 1: 19-20

19 For in Him all the fullness of God was pleased  
to dwell,

20 And through Him to reconcile all things to  
Himself, having made peace through the blood of  
His cross—through Him—whether things on  
earth or things in heaven.

## Week 12: August 17-23

Colossians 1: 23-24

23 if indeed you continue in the faith firmly grounded and  
steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the gospel,  
which you have heard, which was proclaimed in all creation  
under heaven, and of which I, Paul, was made a minister.

24 Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and I fill up  
what is lacking of Christ's afflictions in my flesh, on behalf  
of His body, which is the church,

## Week 14: Aug 31- Sept 6

Colossians 1: 27-28

27 to whom God willed to make known what is the  
riches of the glory of this mystery among the  
Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

28 Him we proclaim, admonishing every man and  
teaching every man with all wisdom, so that we  
may present every man complete in Christ.

## Week 16: Sept 14-20

Colossians 2: 2-3

2 so that their hearts may be encouraged, having  
been held together in love, even unto all the  
wealth of the full assurance of understanding,  
unto the full knowledge of God's mystery, that  
is, Christ Himself,

3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of  
wisdom and knowledge.

## Week 17: Sept 27-27

Colossians 2: 4-5

- 4 I say this so that no one will delude you with persuasive argument.
- 5 For even though I am absent in body, nevertheless I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the stability of your faith in Christ.

## Week 18: Sept 28- Oct 4

Colossians 2: 6-7

- 6 Therefore as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him,
- 7 having been firmly rooted and being built up in Him, and having been established in your faith—just as you were instructed—and abounding with thanksgiving.

## Week 19: October 5-11

Colossians 2: 8-9

- 8 See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, and not according to Christ.
- 9 For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells bodily,

## Week 20: October: 12-18

Colossians 2: 10-11

- 10 and in Him you have been filled, who is the head over all rule and authority;
- 11 in whom you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh, in the circumcision of Christ,

## Week 21: October 19-25

Colossians 2: 12-13

- 12 having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
- 13 And you being dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive with Him, having graciously forgiven us all our transgressions.

## Week 22: Oct 26- Nov 1

Colossians 2:14-15

- 14 Having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us which was hostile to us, He also has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
- 15 Having disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them in Him.

## Week 23: Nov 2-8

Colossians 2: 16-17

- 16 Therefore, no one is to judge you in food and drink, or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day—
- 17 things which are only a shadow of what is to come; but the substance belongs to Christ.

## Week 24: Nov 9-15

Colossians 2: 18-19

- 18 Let no one keep defrauding you of your prize by delighting in self-abasement and the worship of the angels, going into detail about visions he has seen, being puffed up for nothing by his fleshly mind,
- 19 and not holding fast to the head, from whom the entire body, being supplied and held together by the joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God.



## Week 25: Nov 16-22

Colossians 2: 20-21

20 If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do you submit yourself to decrees:

21 "Do not handle, nor taste, nor touch"?

## Week 26: Nov 23-29

Colossians 2: 22-23

22 Which deal with everything destined to perish with use, which are in accordance with the commands and teachings of men;

23 which are matters having, to be sure, a word of wisdom in self-made religion and self-abasement and severe treatment of the body, but are of no value against fleshly indulgence.

## Week 27: Nov 30-Dec 6

Colossians 3: 1-2

1 Therefore, if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

2 Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.

## Week 28: Dec 7-13

Colossians 3: 3-4

3 For you died and your life has been hidden with Christ in God.

4 When Christ, who is our life, is manifested, then you also will be manifested with Him in glory.

## Week 29: Dec 14-20

Colossians 3: 5-6

5 Therefore, consider the members of your earthly body as dead to sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which is idolatry.

6 On account of these things, the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience,

## Week 30: Dec 21-27

Colossians 3: 7-8

7 and in them you also once walked, when you were living in them.

8 But now you also, lay them all aside: wrath, anger, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth.

## Week 31: Dec 28- Jan 3

Colossians 3: 9-10

9 Do not lie to one another, since you put off the old man with its evil practices,  
10 and have put on the new man who is being renewed to a full knowledge according to the image of the One who created him—

## Week 32: Jan 4-10

11 a renewal in which there is no distinction between Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, and freeman, but Christ is all and in all.

12 So, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience;

## Week 33: Jan 11-17

13 bearing with one another, and graciously forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone, just as the Lord graciously forgave you, so also should you.

14 Above all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

## Week 34: Jan 18-24

15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body, and be thankful.

16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with gratefulness in your hearts to God.

## Week 35: Jan 25-31

17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

18 Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

## Week 36: Feb 1-7

19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be embittered against them.

20 Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is pleasing to the Lord.

## Week 37: Feb 8-14

21 Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.

22 Slaves, in all things obey those who are your masters according to the flesh, not with eye service, as men-pleasers, but with integrity of heart, fearing the Lord.

## Week 38: Feb 15-21

23 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men,

24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. Serve the Lord Christ.

## Week 39 Feb 22-28

25 For he who does wrong will receive the consequences of the wrong which he has done, and that without partiality.

Col 4:1 Masters, show to your slaves what is right and fair, knowing that you too have a Master in heaven.

## Week 40 Mar 1-7

2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving;

3 praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been bound,

## Week 41 Mar 8-14

4 that I may make it manifest in the way I ought to speak.

5 Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, redeeming the time.

## Week 42 Mar 15-21

6 Let your words always be with grace,  
seasoned with salt, so that you will know how  
you should answer each person.

7 Tychicus, our beloved brother and faithful  
servant and fellow slave in the Lord, will make  
known to you all my affairs,

## Week 43 Mar 22-28

8 whom I have sent to you for this very purpose,  
that you may know about our circumstances and  
that he may encourage your hearts;

9 and with him Onesimus, our faithful and  
beloved brother, who is one of you. They will  
inform you about the whole situation here.

## Week 44 Mar 29- April 4

10 Aristarchus, my fellow prisoner, sends you his  
greetings; and also Mark, the cousin of Barnabas  
(about whom you received instructions; if he comes  
to you, welcome him);

11 and also Jesus who is called Justus. These are the  
only fellow workers for the kingdom of God who are  
from the circumcision, and they have proved to be a  
comfort to me.

## Week 45 April 5-11

12 Epaphras, who is one of your number, a slave of Christ  
Jesus, sends you his greetings, always striving for you in  
his prayers, that you may stand complete and fully assured  
in all the will of God.

13 For I testify for him that he has a deep concern for you  
and for those who are in Laodicea and Hierapolis.

## Week 46 April 12-18

14 Luke, the beloved physician, sends  
you his greetings, and also Demas.

15 Greet the brothers who are in  
Laodicea and also Nympha and the  
church that is in her house.

## Week 47 April 19-25

16 And when this letter is read among you,  
have it also read in the church of the  
Laodiceans; and you, for your part read my  
letter that is coming from Laodicea.

17 And say to Archippus, "Take heed to  
the ministry which you have received in  
the Lord, that you may fulfill it."

## Week 48 April 26-May 2

18 The greeting is in my own hand—  
Paul. Remember my chains. Grace be  
with you.
